The European Union Center announces the EUC Faculty Travel Grant competition for AY 2016-17. These grants are designed to support the professional development of University of Illinois EU Studies faculty. Funding can be used for research travel or to present a paper at an academic conference. We have three \$1000 grants and one \$800 grant available this semester. All awards MUST be used no later than August 1, 2017. Please note that any international travel must be approved by the US Department of Education 30 days in advance of a scheduled flight. This travel grant is funded by the US Department of Education Title VI grant.

Preference will be given to applicants who have made contributions to European/EU studies at Illinois, who have a demonstrated interest in contributing to the EUC's mission, who are junior or at early stages in their career, and who can demonstrate lack of other sources for the proposed travel.

Travel award recipients may be invited to present a brown bag talk in the EUC lecture series or share their research in other ways with the EUC community.

Grant funds may be used for airfare, lodging, per diem, conference registration fee etc.

Applications should include one copy of the following documents:

- A completed application form available at <http://europe.illinois.edu/resources/faculty-funding>
- A one-page proposal with a description of the proposed travel and the expected benefits to your research and the general area of European/EU studies;
- A budget for the travel and conference expenses;
- For conference travel, please attach a copy of the announcement of the conference and a notice showing that the proposed paper has been accepted for the conference;
- A brief curriculum vitae.

Announcement of awards will be made by February 10, 2017.

All application materials must be submitted by no later than 4:00 pm on Friday, February 3, 2017.
