


Sagrada Alhambra Familia

Visual appearance: Black and white


Instead of dialogue – title cards (words on screen)
Music used to represent sounds
Acting that emphasizes facial and body expressions

Focus on eyes: close up shots of eyes, shooting through the end of binoculars

Double exposure – PEPE!!!




Which parts of the story did you expect? Which elements of the film surprised you?
