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


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### The European Union: 446 million people – 27 countries









- 20 Sept 2019 Fridays for Future climate strike
- 1 Dec 2019 Ursula von der Leyen takes office as President of the new European Commission
- 11 Dec 2019 The European Green Deal published by the European Commission
- 12. Dec 2019 European Council conclusions endorse the goal of climate neutrality by 2050
- Feb 2020 First Covid cases in the EU
- 4 March 2020 European Climate Law proposal (agreed 30 June)
  - Climate neutrality 2050
  - -55% from 1990 level by 2030

### The European Climate Law

Commission Proposal 4.3.2020

### Climate Neutrality Objective 2050

- By September 2020, the Commission shall review the Union's 2030 climate target in light of the climate-neutrality objective [40%], and explore options for a new 2030 target of 50 to 55%
- By 30 June 2021, the Communication shall assess how the Union legislation we need to be amended in order to enable the achievement of 50 to 55 % and to achieve the climate-neutrality-objective, and consider taking the necessary measures

- Commission empowered to set out a trajectory at Union level to achieve the climate-neutrality objective, via delegated acts
- By 30 September 2023, and every 5 years thereafter, the Commission shall assess, together with the assessment foreseen under Article 29(5) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1000\* the collective progress made by 55% target now part of the climate law

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
## 3. The "Fit for 55" package: transport aspects

Released on 14 July 2021

14 legal proposals and 3 non-legislative actions

- Passenger car limits and electrification:
  - Revision of the CO₂ emission standards for passenger cars and light commercial vehicles,
- Energy infrastructure in transport:
  - Revision of the Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Directive and conversion into a regulation (AFIR),
- Renewable energy in transport:
  - Revision of the **Renewable Energy Directive** (RED III),
  - Introduction of sustainable fuels in aviation (ReFuelEU Aviation),
  - o Introduction of sustainable fuels in maritime shipping (FuelEU Maritime),
- Pricing of energy and CO<sub>2</sub> in transport, and social compensation:
  - Revision of the EU Emissions Trading Scheme (EU ETS) to include maritime shipping and the creation of an additional emissions trading scheme for buildings and transport,
  - Revision of the Energy Taxation Directive,
  - Revision of the aviation emissions trading scheme,
  - Creation of a **Social Climate Fund.**

### Some things to bear in mind about decarbonisation

- Decarbonising land transport requires [not only] electrification.
  - The decarbonisation of electricity generation is indispensable, but separate. Linking the two only causes friction and slowdown.
  - Alternative fuels are no solution (except in aviation and maritime transport): too scarce, too expensive
- Will a sustainable economy be possible with an unchanged economic paradigm?
- Parallel crises
  - Climate & biodiversity
  - COVID and its aftermath
  - The Ukraine war

- 8 Mar 2022: Communication "REPowerEU: Joint European action for more affordable, secure and sustainable energy"

 Mar 2022: IEA - A 10-Point Plan to Cut Oil Use

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
